The studded spout supports the minimum amount of body design that this piece showcases. A study in simplicity, the Matakam culture is well known for their simplistic designs. This jar was used to hold wine and is a reason for the lack of intricate designs. The thin spout allows for a stopper to be placed in the hole.
